

# Adventurous Sky

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## Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets:** Adventurous Sky (163439) or 10% off with the dies (163447)
- **Cardstock & Paper:** Smoky Slate (131202), Night of Navy (100867), Basic White (159276), Take to the Sky 12" x 12" Designer Series Paper [or DSP] (163436)
- **Stamp Pad:** Basic Gray (149165), Night of Navy (147110)
- **Tools:** Take Your Pick Tool (144107), Bone Folder (102300); Paper Snips (103579), Paper Trimmer (152392), Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653)
- **Miscellaneous:** Adventurous Sky Dies (163446) or 10% off with the stamp set (163447), Stampin' Blends Combo Packs in Boho Blue (161659), Copper Clay (161662), Basic Black (154843), and Smoky Slate (154904), Rhinestone Basic Jewels (144220), Stampin' Dimensionals (104430), Mini Glue Dots (103683), Multipurpose Liquid Glue or "Glue" (110755), household tape

## Measurements:

- Smoky Slate: 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" scored at 4-1/4", folded then burnished with the Bone Folder
- Night of Navy: 3-3/4" x 5"
- Designer Series Paper: 3-1/2" x 4-3/4"
- Basic White: 4" x 2-1/2", 3-1/2" x 1-1/2" (4), 2-1/2" x 1/2"

## Instructions:

1. Glue DSP to Night of Navy panel.
2. Stamp airplane on largest Basic White cardstock and color in with Stampin' Blends. Die cut airplane and set aside.
3. Stamp sentiment with Night of Navy on Basic White strip then die cut. Using Paper Snips, trim triangle end so whole banner is about 2-1/4" long.
4. Die cut tiny piece that will hold edge of banner with Night of Navy cardstock. Use glue to attach it to the right edge of the sentiment banner.
5. Die cut 4 clouds so the long straighter edge is off the cardstock. You want a straight edge on all four. Once die cut, tape two together, from back side, so straight edges meet. Repeat to create second cloud.
6. Glue airplane to one cloud so the wings cover the seam between the two cloud halves.
7. Glue remaining cloud at an angle and towards right in a position so the bottom edge of wing will cover it when second goes on top of it.
8. With dots of glue, attach banner piece to back of airplane.

9. With Stampin' Dimensionals (including one cut in half for banner) attach cloud/plane piece to card front at an angle so it covers the seam on the cloud that is on the DSP panel.
10. Color three rhinestones with Dark Night of Navy Stampin' Blends and adhere to card using your Take Your Pick Tool.
11. Attach DSP/airplane panel to card front with Stampin' Dimensionals.
