

# Frosted Forest

## Supplies:

- **Stamp Set** – Frosted Forest (164344)
- **Cardstock** – Basic White Cardstock (159276); Mossy Meadow (133676); Season of Green & Gold 12”x12” Specialty Designer Series Paper (164324)
- **Stamp Pads** – Memento Tuxedo Black (132708); Old Olive (147090)
- **Misc.** – Frosted Forest Dies (164136); Frosted Forest Decorative Masks (164350); Frosted Forest Bundle (164137); Timber 3D Embossing Folder (156406); Greetings of the Season Dies (164112); Linen Thread (104199); Cherry Cobbler & Pearl Adhesive-Backed Berries, Old Olive Stampin’ Blends (154892); Pecan Pie Stampin’ Blends (161674); Crumb Cake Stampin’ Blends (154882); Blending Brush (153611)

## Measurements:

- Basic White Card Stock: 5-1/2” x 8-1/2” scored at 4-1/4”
- Basic White Card Stock: 4” x 5-1/4”; 1-1/2” x 2-1/4”; 1” x 1-1/4”; 3” x 4-1/4”
- Mossy Meadow: 2-3/4” x 4-1/4”

- Designer Series Paper: 2-3/4" x 4-1/4"
- Linen Thread: approx. 3"

**Instructions:**

1. Fold Basic White card stock in half to make a card base.
2. Place Basic White card stock in the embossing folder and emboss with a die cutting machine. Attach to the card base.
3. Die cut two tags from Mossy Meadow card stock and Designer Series Paper using the largest tag die.
4. Offset the tags and attach to the card.
5. Stamp a tree on Basic White card stock with Black ink.
6. Color with Light Old Olive and Pecan Pie Stampin' Blends.
7. Place mask # 3 over the tree image. Apply Old Olive ink with a Blending Brush.
8. Die cut with the coordinating die and attach to the card using Stampin' Dimensionals.
9. Die cut a tag with the small tag die from Basic White card stock. Stamp the sentiment with Black ink. Fold Linen Thread in half and feed through the hole in the tag. Open the loop and feed through the ends of the Linen Thread. Attach to the card using Stampin' Dimensionals.
10. Stamp a bird with Black ink. Color with Crumb Cake Stampin' Blends. Die cut with the coordinating die. Attach to the card using a Stampin' Dimensional.
