

Spooky Halloween

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Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets:** Spooky Halloween (166192) or as a bundle with the dies (166199)
- **Paper:** Pumpkin Pie (105117), Basic White (166780), Basic Black (121045) Spooky Sweet 12" x 12" Specialty Designer Series Paper or "DSP" (199191)
- **Stamp Pads:** Tuxedo Black Memento Ink (132708)
- **Miscellaneous:** Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653), Paper Trimmer (152392), Spooky Halloween Dies (166198) or discounted with the stamps (166199), Stampin' Blends Combo Packs in Pumpkin Pie (154897), Highland Heather (154887), Daffodil Delight (154883), Smoky Slate (154904) and Basic Black (154843), Neutral Matte Dots (165561), Multipurpose Liquid Glue or "glue" (110755), Mini Stampin' Dimensionals (144108), Bone Folder (102300)

Measurements:

- Pumpkin Pie: 4-1/4" x 11" scored at 5-1/2" and burnished with the Bone Folder, 3-5/8" x 5", scraps for sentiment
- DSP: 4-1/4" x 5-1/2" for background, 3-3/8" x 4-3/4" front door image as shown
- Basic White: 3" x 3"
- Basic Black: scraps for three bats

Instructions:

1. Using glue, adhere the background DSP to the card base then adhere the front door DSP piece to Pumpkin Pie layer. Add that layer to card front with glue.
2. Stamp cat witch and broom with Tuxedo Memento onto Basic White. Color in with Stampin' Blends. Die cut both. Add broom to cat's hand with a dot of glue.
3. Die cut bats from Basic Black scraps.
4. Cover half of sentiment with tape or a Post-It Note, ink other half, remove mask and stamp onto Pumpkin Pie scrap. Repeat with other word. Cut both close to the word so it's rectangular. With glue, add to card front at an angle.
5. Add cat witch and three bats with Mini Stampin' Dimensionals.

6. Add three black Neutral Matte Dots.
